Dear Resident/Representative:

We were notified this morning that one associate tested positive for COVID-19 as a result of our twice a week universal testing we complete here at GreenFields. The associate last worked on 11/19/20 and is asymptomatic at this time. The associate was removed from the schedule to allow time to recover at home.

Our associate case count in Briarwood since the beginning of March through today has a cumulative total of thirteen (13) cases. Our resident case count since the beginning of March is at five (5). All previously identified associates and residents have recovered, and we extend our prayers to the current associates and residents for a promising recovery as well.

We continue to keep the health and safety of our GreenFields residents and associates as our highest priorities, and we recognize the uncertainty and concern regarding the evolving Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. We are following guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, IDPH and the Kane County Health Department to mitigate any potential of a COVID spread in our community.

Every associate continues to be screened daily with symptoms and temperature assessment before entering the community and at mid-shift. We continue to focus on infection control measures by assuring all staff members are wearing personal protective equipment for the entirety of their work shifts, promotion of hand washing/hand sanitizing and physical distancing whenever possible. We continue to disinfect high touch areas and have increased cleaning schedules.
